- ✓ Discover Hang Chuot (Rat Cave), the filming location for the movies Kong: Skull Island and Nguoi Bat Tu (The Immortal).
- ✓ Experience a local lunch at a villager's home, where you can enjoy delicious dishes and discover the special stories of the Nguon people in this area.

Itinerary

MORNING

9:00 AM: Tour guide picks up guests at the Oxalis office in Tan Hoa. Introduce Tu Lan Lodge, a weather-adaptive accommodation model aiming for Net-Zero sustainability.

Explore Tan Hoa Village by bike, and visit the households providing homestay services and home-cooked services.

Lunch at a local home: Savor authentic local dishes prepared by the homeowners themselves, including a taste of 'Boi' prepared by the Nguon people, while learning about their culture, customs, and traditions.

AFTERNOON

Travelers have two options.

Option 1: Join an ATV riding experience.

This tour presents a special opportunity to explore the precious Lim Garden of Mr. Do while riding an ATV Quad Bike. Lasting approximately 2 hours, it allows participants to navigate through the garden on off-road bikes, discovering the ancient Lim trees. Additionally, the ATV activity contributes to fundraising efforts that support the locals dedicated to preserving this precious Lim garden.

Option 2: Discover Rat Cave, the filming location for the movies Kong: Skull Island and Nguoi Bat Tu (The Immortal).

This 3-hour trek takes you through the pristine cave system with breathtaking stalactites, previously used as a film set. You will feel like a true explorer, yet the trip is not overly strenuous as Rat Cave is located at the forest's edge, accessible by motorbike or bicycle. The tour wraps up by 4 PM.
